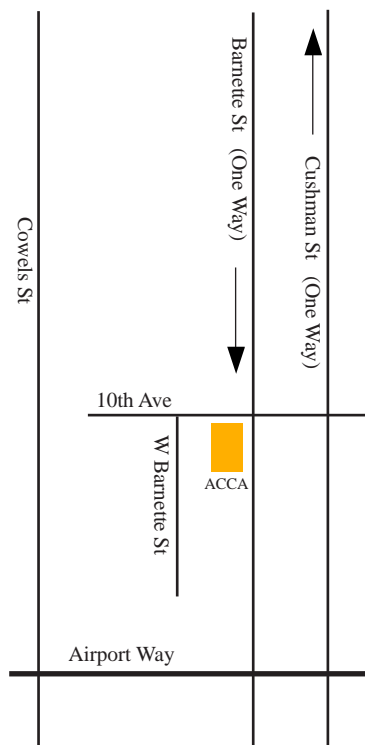

# Our History

ACCA began in the 1950's as a statewide network of concerned citizens, who established resource and referral services to help people access medical and adaptive equipment services. Throughout the years, ACCA has maintained its focus on services to children, adults and families who experience many types of disabilities.

Today, ACCA programs provide services focusing on supporting family members with disabilities in everyday home routines, school and community activities. Our mission is to assist in improving the lives of people with disabilities and their families by providing quality diagnostic, therapeutic, educational and referral services in conjunction with other community providers without regard to ability to pay.

ACCA programs serve communities in the Interior, North Slope and South Central regions of Alaska. We are a 501(c)3 Non-Profit Corporation and receive funding from private and public funding sources.

## Programs

### Infant Learning Program

The Infant Learning Program (ILP) is a resource for families during the first three years of their children's lives.

ILP services include developmental screenings and evaluations, home visits to coach caregivers how to best help their infant's individual needs, and various therapies to promote appropriate development in infants.

### Speech Clinic

ACCA's Speech Clinic provides Speech/Language Pathology treatment to young adults and adults in the Fairbanks region. We provide services without regard to ability to pay.

The focus of ACCA's Speech Clinic is treatment of acquired brain injuries (traumatic brain injury, blast-related injury, stroke, etc.) and augmentative communication.

### FACES Team

ACCA's Fetal Alcohol Community Evaluation Services (FACES) Team helps children prenatally exposed to alcohol, along with their families, access the resources to help them with difficulties they may face.

The Team is comprised of a variety of professionals working together to screen, evaluate, diagnose and make recommendations for intervention for the child's family.

### Loan Closet

Adaptive equipment is available for short term loan to community members for a small cleaning fee and a refundable deposit.

Available equipment includes wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, bedside commodes, shower chairs, and other items. The Loan Closet helps people become mobile when they need it most.
